Post-Fire Data & Assessment Workshop Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District

The San Mateo Fire Safe Council invites you to join us on **June 12th, 2019 from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm** for a series of presentations by Staff and consultants with Sonoma County Ag & Open Space, who will be sharing data and analysis performed on the Sonoma Complex Fires of 2017.

Key discussion topics to include:

- The Sonoma County Vegetation Mapping and LiDAR Program, which is similar to current ongoing countywide fine scale vegetation mapping efforts in San Mateo and Marin.
- * NASA Funded research designed to update existing Sonoma vegetation data sets and analyze the impact of the fires across the landscape, and to discover and quantify relationships between fire damage and landscape characteristics such as vegetation, weather, land use, and land management patterns.
- * Overview and results from a survey to understand the use of Sonoma's Vegetation Mapping and Land Cover Map Products in fire response, post-fire recovery and resilience planning.
